## PHOTOSHOOT PREPARATIONS

In the 100's and 100's of photoshoots I have done in the past 20+ years, I always see a tendency for the clients or models to just assume I can fix everything in Photoshop. That might be true but that takes time which costs me money. I would request that for the forthcoming photoshoot you do your best to complete the check list.

TRY AND NOT CONSUME ALCOHOL THE NIGHT BEFORE. If so, please be moderate. This will show up in your eyes.
Get a good nights sleep and drink water. <i>This will show up in your eyes and face</i> .
Manage your body hair. If you wax, make sure this has been done recently. Armpits, bikini line, nose hair, etc. I am shooting medium format and the detail captured is very precise.
Most of the time I am providing wardrobe (including jewelry) but please have your hair and makeup ready. Having a bold color for lipstick and a mild color is recommended. I appreciate if eyeliner and mascara are bold and beautiful and then the lipstick should match. Subtle is ok, but, think of any of these shots being on the cover of a fashion magazine. Hands and feet should be addressed as well. Fashion hand and toe nails are great but not required. Just make sure your nails are trimmed neatly or fashionably. Make a statement. Be proud of your beauty. You are unique and brand yourself unique.
If this the first time shooting with me, you will hear me frequently say "smile and breathe" Usually this is at the beginning of the shoot until you can feel relaxed. My goal is to bring your insides to your outside beauty and hopefully make art that makes the world a better place We all have our own responsibility to do that.
